Completion of Aktina Solar Power Plant in the USA

Tokyo Gas America Ltd. (President: INUKAI Akira), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Tokyo Gas Co., Ltd. (President: SASAYAMA Shinichi) (“Tokyo Gas Group”), has completed the construction of the "Aktina Solar Power Project"*¹ (the "Project") in the state of Texas in the USA. The entire construction process of the Project was divided into four phases, with partial operations beginning in August 2021, and the Project is now fully operational from December 2023. The maximum output of the Project is 631MWdc, making it one of the largest solar power plants in the USA.



Tokyo Gas Group will apply the knowledge we have gained through this Project regarding development, construction, and business operations of solar power generation to the development of renewable energy projects in Japan and overseas.

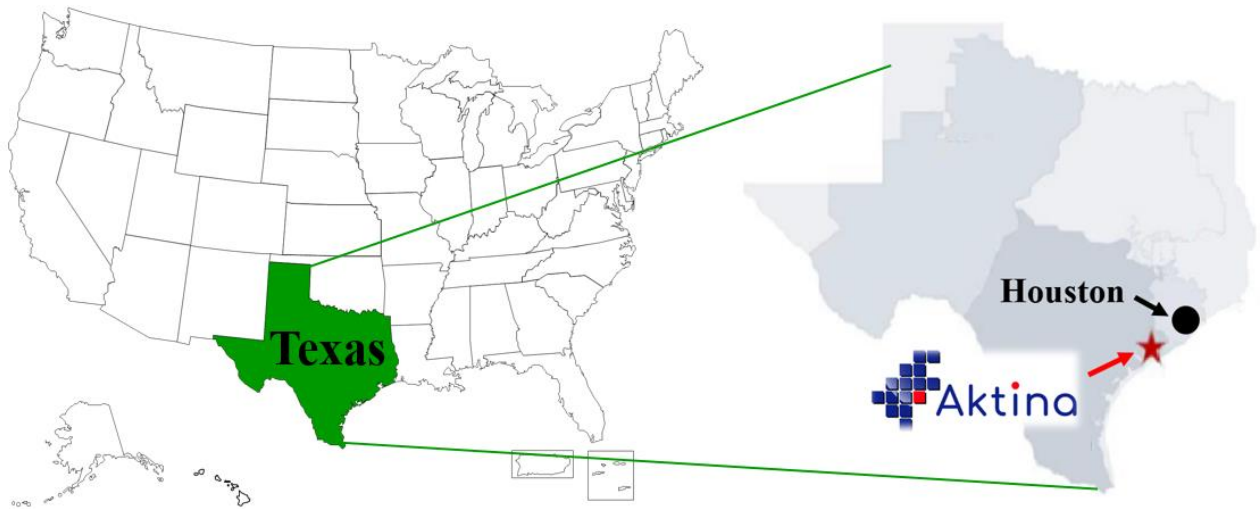
In the USA, Tokyo Gas Group also plans to participate in the battery energy storage industry*², which together with this Project will contribute to the power supply in Texas and strengthen our earnings base toward our overseas business profit target of 50 billion yen*³.

Tokyo Gas Group has set forth the "Challenge to achieve net zero CO₂ emissions" in its management vision "Compass 2030." We will continue to contribute to the realization of a decarbonized society by aiming to achieve a renewable energy transaction volume of 6 million kW in Japan and overseas.
